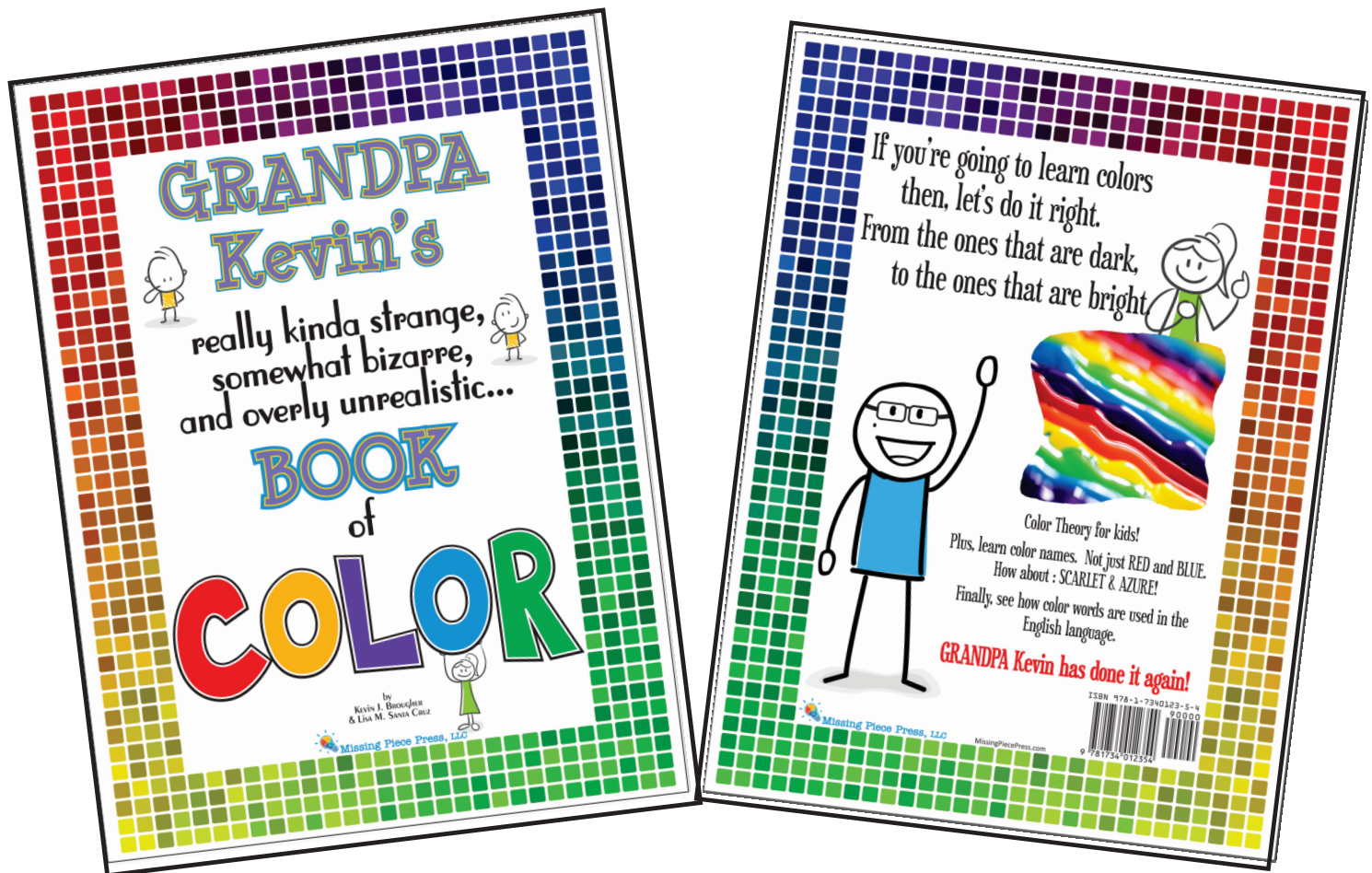

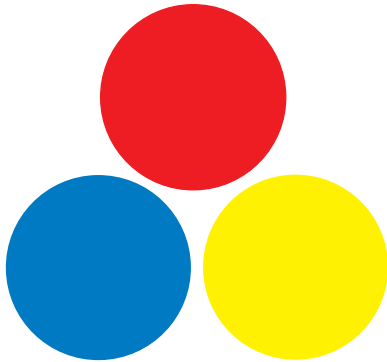

could be so complex!

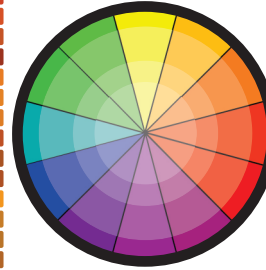
But, the first part is easy -

RED Flag : Used as a warning of danger.

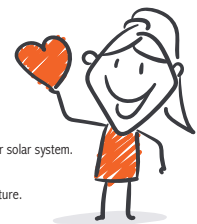
RED Line : Is the recommended safety limit.
